Conference Venue, Distinction Rotorua Hotel & Conference Centre, Rotorua

The NZCS 50th Anniversary Conference will take place at the Distinction Rotorua Hotel & Conference Centre, Rotorua, New Zealand.

Distinction Rotorua is situated at 390 Fenton Street, just seconds away from the Central Business District and close to the famous Whakarewarewa Thermal Reserve, the beautiful mature Redwood Forest and the New Zealand Maori Arts and Crafts Institute, Te Puia. Excellent shopping, tourist activities and nightlife are all within a 5 minute drive of the hotel.

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Conference satchel

Trade Exhibition

A trade exhibition will be held at the conference. In order to provide you with the optimum exposure to delegates the exhibition will be located in the Fenton Foyer, of the Distinction Rotorua Hotel & Conference Centre.

Trade Exhibition Stands

There are three stand sizes available for you to select from. You may book adjoining stands to create a larger exhibition area.

- Size A 4.2m wide x 1.2m deep x 2.3m high \$2,950 + GST
- Size B 3.0m wide x 1.2m deep x 2.3m high \$1,650 + GST
- Size C 1.8m wide x 1.2m deep x 2.3m high \$ 950 + GST

The basic setup provided for stands are side and back partitioned walls. The configuration of individual stands may vary. Each stand will include the following:

- Velcro receptive display panels
- 1 x 10 AMP power supply and a multi-box
- 2 x 100 watt spot lights
- A trestle table, table cloth and a chair
- Installation and removal of basic set up

Internet access can be provided at an additional cost. Any additional requirements will be the responsibility of exhibitors and at their own cost.

Exhibitor Benefits

Each exhibiting company will receive the following benefits:

- Acknowledged as an exhibitor with a name listing in the conference handbook.
- Trade attendant registrations. Trade attendant registration entitles the recipient to entry to the trade exhibition, morning tea, lunch and afternoon tea. It does not include entry into conference sessions or social events.
 - Size A 3 free trade attendant registrations
 - Size B 2 free trade attendant registrations
 - Size C 1 free trade attendant registration

Site

The trade exhibition area floor plan shows the sites of trades exhibition stands. Exhibit sites will be allocated on a first-in basis.

Please note, once your position chosen this will not be changed. However, your stand number may change. We will confirm your stand number closer to the conference dates. This will ensure any printed material, if you choose to produce any, will have your correct stand details.

Lunches, morning & afternoon tea breaks will be held in this area.

In order to maintain the integrity of the conference the exhibition stands must not be taken down until after the closing address of the conference.

Cancellation Policy

All cancellations must be notified in writing by fax or email to the conference organiser. Cancellations received **on or before 5 pm Monday 17 May 2010** will receive a refund less an administration fee of \$200 + GST. All sponsors and exhibitors cancelling after **5 pm Monday 17 May 2010** will be liable for full costs of their commitment. In the event of the conference being cancelled a full refund less \$200 + GST administration fee will be charged.




